Temporary Order in Response *
to the Novel COVID-19 Public *
Health Crisis

The Presiding Judge of the Perrysburg Municipal Court, Wood County, Ohio, makes the following Orders in alignment with the on-going response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis and in accordance with Administrative Order Nos. 2020-04, 2020-05 and 2020-06. The Court will begin to phase-in regular court operations on 05-18-2020, taking into account the health and safety of the public, to maintain essential court functions and to continue to protect the rights of all individuals served by the Court. Temporary Orders are as follows:

- 1. Face Covering(s)** - Beginning 05-18-2020, face coverings will be required of the public, court employees and other individuals seeking entry into the Perrysburg Municipal Court and be required to be worn in all areas accessible to the public. Social distancing rules will be enforced where practicable.
- 2. Continuing Operations** - All felony and in-custody cases will continue as scheduled.
- 3. Criminal (CRB) Cases** - Scheduling of CRB designated cases will resume on a limited basis beginning 05-18-2020.
- 4. Traffic (TRD) Cases** - Scheduling of TRD designated cases will resume on a limited basis beginning 05-18-2020. This includes all arraignment hearings, pre-trial conferences, plea hearings, motion hearings and all trial(s) on all traffic designated cases. Traffic related probation violation hearings will be scheduled by the Court.

5. **O.V.I. (TRC) Cases** - Scheduling of TRC designated cases will resume on a limited basis beginning 05-18-2020.
6. **Jury Trial(s)** - Jury trials will be scheduled with the Assignment Clerk.
7. **Probation Supervision Reporting** – All probation supervision reporting shall continue to take place via telephone unless specifically ordered by the Probation Department or the Court.
8. **Civil (CVG, CVF, CVE, CVH, CVI) Cases** - Scheduling of Civil designated cases will resume on a limited basis beginning 05-18-2020.
